

- Antje Skilman;²⁰ died 29 April 1835, age 81 years 10 months 3 days [sic, this calculates to a birth in 1753], in Union, Broome County, New York;²¹ married say 1790 **BETSEY VAN DUYN**.
- iii. **ABRAHAM SKILLMAN**, born 13 March 1757/8, baptized 18 February 1759 at Six Mile Run Dutch Reformed Church, child of John and Anna Skilman;²² died young, see below.
- iv. **ABRAHAM SKILLMAN**, born 13 September 1760, baptized 15 August 1762 at Six Mile Run Dutch Reformed Church, child of Johannis and Anna Skilman;²³ married say 1781 **MARY SUNDERLAND**.
- v. **JOHN SKILLMAN**, born 26 April 1762, baptized 25 September 1763 at Six Mile Run, child of John and Enne Skilman;²⁴ living in 1817 when he signed as executor of his father's will; never married.
- vi. **THOMAS SKILLMAN**, born 13 December 1765; married, but wife's name unknown.
- vii. **JANE SKILLMAN**, born 14 October 1768; never married.
- viii. **ISAAC SKILLMAN**, born 27 August 1770; married first 16 November 1795 **SUSANNA SANSBURY**; married second 15 October 1807 **CATHARINE CLENDENNING**.
- ix. **SAMUEL SKILLMAN**, born 6 April 1773; died 12 March 1851; married by say 1802 **REBECCA** —, who was born about 1779 or 1780 (calculated); died 6 March 1854, aged 74; both buried in Princeton Cemetery.
- x. **ELIZABETH SKILLMAN**, born 31 August 1776.
